Bev said that the funding that had remained unused had been returned to groundworks this amount being £2,676.20 of unused monies. Luke said that locality can help with technical issues i.e. the character assessment. Luke is to send the form to Bev to enable her to apply to locality for funding

It was decided that we needed to get the leaflets out post haste asking who may have available land on which they would consider offering up for sale for building. Angela Scott enquired about the land up Gainsborough road Bev replied that as it was part of the parish that leaflets would be distributed up there. Luke explained that we needed to go through this process of delivering leaflets to all the parish even if no land was offered up. It was decided not to put leaflets into the parish magazine as they are more likely not to get read that way. It was decided to contact instant print for a quote. Luke said we need to identify vision objectives i.e. how we want Scotton to change and that we should have a workshop. He suggested that non designated heritage assets should be taken into consideration to form part of the character assessment and that green spaces need to be identified. Dan is halfway through scoping report and is hoping to have it completed by the end of November. He identified that the front of the paddock on the High Street which belongs to Manor farm was once protected but this is no longer the case.
