2.3 <u>A159</u>

A letter of support had been received from Laughton PC and Scotter PC are to discuss this matter at their next meeting.

2.4 <u>ELECTIONS</u>

Six Councillors had submitted nominated forms and were returned uncontested. The Council will co-opt at their May meeting. A parishioner has expressed interest and is to be invited to this meeting .

2.5 <u>SCOTTER LIBRARY</u>

A letter had been received from Scotter Parish Council indicating that the LCC have proposed a cut of 14 hours in the Library service at Scotter. Scotter Parish Council asked for support to fight this cut and Scotton Parish Council agreed to reply saying they would not want to see any dilution of service. A petition is to be put in the pub.

2.6 <u>STREET CLEANING – REPORT AND MEETING</u>

A letter had been received from Mr G Pilkington indicating that the review of street cleaning is now complete and a report will be presented at a meeting on 27th May in The Guildhall. Cllr S Smith volunteered to attend this meeting.

2.7 <u>YEDL</u>

Correspondence received regarding Scotton Low Voltage Overhead Line Refurbishment Scheme. The work will involve renewing the majority of the poles and replacing the existing overhead wires. A plan was sent but there is no date for the work as yet.
