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The Parish Council noted that all three applications had not submitted reports on how access, congestion and drainage issues would be managed. The Council had written to Severn Trent Water to enquire about the capacity of existing drains and were advised that the sewage network in the village only captured foul water. Water run-off and surface water should be dealt with by soakaways. This concluded that existing sewage infrastructure was not designed to cope with surface water and run-off. The increased volumes of water or the connection of storm drains to the foul water drains, could increase the risk of flooding, both in the village and to the neighbouring village of Scotter.
