A letter had been received from LCC Highways saying that there would be new policies drawn up for all A and B roads this year. It was agreed to reply reiterating that Scotton PC still advocate a 50mph speed limit for this road and asking to be kept informed with regard to the new policy.

A letter had also been received from Scotter Parish Council saying that they were interested in working with Scotton PC to improve traffic problems in the area but that they would not support the bid for a 50mph speed limit on the A159.
