This is classed as green space but the village chose not to have it as **protected** green space . There has been no communication with the village hall committee about a community hub.

The parish council have no jurisdiction over it or how it is run, and it is already protected by its own legislation. The Parish Council request that the words "proposed and community hub" be removed so as not to mislead parishioners.
