## 6.2 RECORDING OF MEETINGS

Audit Commission consultation regarding recording of meeting caused concern and it was agreed to respond pointing out that covert recording should be illegal and that if anyone wishes to record a meeting they should give prior notice of their intention. Concern was raised with regard to anyone wishing to conceal their identity or who have been given new identities. Putting their picture on the internet could compromise their rights. The Councillors felt that by standing as a councillor they were putting themselves into the public domain but anyone attending a meeting as a parishioner should be protected as it infringes privacy and civil liberty.
